Dear Parishioners,

Today's Feast of the Body and Blood of Our Lord, is a special celebration of the gift of the Eucharist. Dt 8:2-3, 14b-16a

Moses said to the people:

"Remember how for forty years now the LORD, your God, has directed all your journeying in the desert, so as to test you by affliction and find out whether or not it was your intention to keep his commandments. He therefore let you be afflicted with hunger, and then fed you with manna, a food unknown to you and your fathers, in order to show you that not by bread alone does one live, but by every word that comes forth from the mouth of the LORD.

Jesus said to the Jewish crowds:


"I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world."

The Jews quarreled among themselves, saying, "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?" Jesus said to them, "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him. Just as the living Father sent me and I have life because of the Father, so also the one who feeds on me will have life because of me. This is the bread that came down from heaven. Unlike your ancestors who ate and still died, whoever eats this bread will live forever."

that have yet to be completed. A sprinkling system will be installed to keep our new landscaping green. Asphalt will be laid to have a safe path for those coming to the food pantry. Additional lighting on May Street will be installed for security reasons. The Winter left significant damage to both the Church roof and the parish center roof. These damages came to about \$50,000. Thank God our insurance will cover most of it. We hope to begin the restoration of our historic front doors this summer. We wanted to restore rather than replace the doors, they are 151 years old and have welcomed generations into the Church. Door by door they will be taken to a warehouse where they will be repaired, refinished and retro-fitted with code compliant panic bars. Hopefully they will be then in great shape to serve many more generations of people coming to Holy Family!

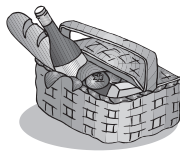

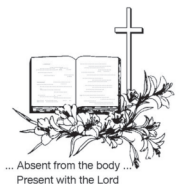
